About the Seminar:

Equal access to education, health, work, and representation in political and economic decision making processes will benefit humanity at large.

Scope and Outline of the Seminar:

Gender inequality is one of the prominent and widespread forms of injustice since ages. As a nation we can achieve the status of a developed nation only by eliminating it. It is also noticed that, as a nation we can make progress towards Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) only if we make gains in the alleviation of destructive forces such as poverty, sexual abuse, malnutrition etc. Goal 5 of SDGs aims to eliminate all forms of discrimination and violence against women in the public and private spheres and to undertake reforms to give women equal rights to economic resources and access to ownership of property.

The Government of India has identified ending violence against women as a key national priority which resonates with the sustainable development targets of the United Nations on Gender Equality. Women and girls continue to suffer discrimination and violence in every part of the world. Gaps in gender equality exist in every sector. One in three women experience some form of physical or sexual violence in their lifetimes.

 - Size: 10

- Line spacing: Single
- The Abstract should be written within 300 words. Abstracts will be peer reviewed before acceptance.
- The final paper should contain maximum 1500 words (apart from title & other details)

- Notification of accepted papers: **30th December, 2019**
- Deadline for Paper Submission: **10th January, 2020**. Only those Papers submitted on or before this date will be eligible for publication in the peer-reviewed multidisciplinary research journal.
